#### Daring to Lead: Leading Educational Schools Where the East Meets the West



#### Xitao FAN

Prof. Fan currently serves as Dean of the Faculty of Education and Wei Lun Professor of Educational Psychology in the Chinese University of Hong Kong (China). Previously, in the Chinese University of Hong Kong (Shenzhen) (2017-2020), he was the Dean of the School of Humanities & Social Science and Presidential Chair Professor; in the University of Macau (2011-2017), he was the Dean of the Faculty of Education and Chair Professor of educational psychology, as well as interim Vice Rector (Academic Affairs). Prior to his career in Asia, he was Curry Memorial Professor, full professor, and associate professor in the Curry School of

Education, University of Virginia (2000-2011), and an associate professor and assistant professor in Utah State University (1993-2000). He obtained Ph.D. (1993) in educational psychology from Texas A&M University (USA), M.A. (1989) in TESL from Brigham Young University (USA), and B.A. (1982) in English language education from the Kunming Institute of Technology (China). Prof. Fan has research/teaching interests in quantitative research methods and applications, educational/psychological measurement, meta-analytic studies, and inter-disciplinary research in education/psychology. He served as the editor (2004-2010) and associate editor (2000-2004) of Educational & Psychological Measurement (SAGE Publications). He was an elected AERA Fellow (2012). Prof. Fan has been involved in numerous research projects funded by U.S. federal agencies, and those funded by University of Macau. With over 200 research articles published in highly competitive journals in education and psychology, and a couple dozens of book chapters, Prof. Fan's research work has been well cited internationally.



#### **Chuang Wang**

Chuang Wang is Distinguished Professor and Dean of the Faculty of Education at the University of Macau. His expertise includes quantitative research methods, English language learner's self-efficacy beliefs, and self-regulated learning strategies. He has received six grants from US National Science Foundations and eight grants from regional education institutions. He has published more than 200 books, book chapters, and journal articles. He has received numerous awards at the national, regional, and university-level in the United States and China for teaching, research, and service. He served as the Editor-in-Chief of two peer-reviewed journals and the President of the Chinese American Educational Research and Development

Association (2008-2010). He is currently Associate Director of the Board for Jiangsu-Hong Kong-Macau University Alliance for Teacher Education and the Standing Committee member of the South China Hong Kong Macau Research Center. In Macau, Dr. Wang is on the supervisory board for Macau Science Center.


